1. Purpose

This Corporate Structure & Entity Register sets out, openly and in full, the legal entities through which NovaLink — the technology and product provider — operates. It exists so that participants of the Community Platforms it serves, Node Operators, enterprise customers, distributors, partners, regulators and counsel can see exactly which entity is responsible for which part of the business. Transparency about corporate structure is a deliberate choice: a network that asks people to host infrastructure in their homes should be equally clear about who stands behind it.

2. The NovaLink entities at a glance

NovaLink is the technology and product brand that serves independent Community Platforms, each operated by its own Community Operator (see Section 6) — currently NodeLink BVI and HubLink Ltd, with further community platforms able to be added over time. Each Community Operator publishes its own core

agreements (terms and conditions, participation and rewards agreements, privacy policy) on its own platform; participants contract with their Community Operator. NovaLink itself operates through three entities:

It is the seller of record for purchases made through the NovaLink Store and is the entity referred to as the "Store Operator" in this documentation set, including the Terms and Conditions and the Privacy and Cookies Policy. Ntech Link Technologies Ltd is a BVI Business Company, Company Registration No. 2195904.

Because NodeLink USA, Inc. is a United States entity, it is directly subject to United States federal and state law. In particular: (a) it is a "US person" for the purposes of the sanctions administered by the US Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC), and OFAC compliance is a binding legal obligation of NodeLink USA, Inc. (see the Sanctions & OFAC Compliance Policy, NL-SANC-01); (b) it can be served with United States legal process directly, including under the Stored Communications Act (see the Law Enforcement Request Policy, NL-LE-01, Section 3.3); and (c) it is the "business" under the California Consumer Privacy Act / California Privacy Rights Act and equivalent US state privacy laws in respect of the personal information of US residents that it collects (see the US State Privacy Addendum, NL-USPRIV-01).

6. The Community Operators — NodeLink BVI and HubLink Ltd

The communities served by NovaLink are operated by their own independent legal entities, listed here with the same transparency as the NovaLink entities and without preference. Each Community Operator owns and operates its community platform and domain, publishes its own core agreements (terms and conditions, participation and rewards agreements, privacy policy), and is the entity its participants contract with. NovaLink is the technology and product provider referenced by those agreements.

NodeLink BVI — BVI Business Company, Company Registration No. 2191069. Operates the NodeLink community platform and domain, and carries out global distribution and sales for its community.

HubLink Ltd — BVI Business Company, Company Registration No. 2213274. Operates the HubLink community platform and domain, and carries out global distribution and sales for its community.

Additional Community Operators may be added over time; this Register will be updated as they are.

7. How the entities relate

The group is organised around a clear division of function:

- Auralink Nova Technology L.L.C (Dubai) is the Technology Provider. It holds a licence to the Nx1/Hx1 Home Station operating system (which it does not own or develop), integrates that operating system into the Nx1/Hx1 Home Station hardware, and creates the finished product made available to the Community Platforms. It also provides the Auralink consumer applications and maintains NovaLink's rented office in Dubai.
- Ntech Link Technologies Ltd is the Store Operator. It operates the NovaLink Store e-commerce platform together with the payment processors and payment gateways, and is the seller of record for the Nx1/Hx1 Home Station. It does not contract for community membership, participation or rewards — those are governed by each participant's Community Operator.
- NodeLink USA, Inc. (Delaware) carries out market entry, distribution and sales in the United States, onboarding US participants and selling the Nx1/Hx1 Home Station in the US market.
- The Community Operators — currently NodeLink BVI and HubLink Ltd, listed here for transparency and without preference — each operate their own independent community platform under their own core agreements. Additional Community Operators may be added over time. Participants join and contract

with their Community Operator; NovaLink is the technology and product provider referenced by those agreements.

Represented as a simple chain: the operating-system licensor → licenses the Nx1/Hx1 Home Station operating system to → Auralink Nova Technology L.L.C (Technology Provider — integrates the OS into the Nx1/Hx1 Home Station and creates the finished product) → made available through → Ntech Link Technologies Ltd (Store Operator — sells the Nx1/Hx1 Home Station through the NovaLink Store) → purchased by participants of the Community Platforms served by NovaLink. Global distribution and sales are carried out by the Community Operators (currently NodeLink BVI and HubLink Ltd); distribution and sales in the United States are carried out by NodeLink USA, Inc. (Delaware).

Any change in ownership or control will be reflected in a revised version of this Register.
