1. Why we publish a roadmap

Sophisticated technical reviewers, enterprise prospects, regulators, and Node Operators are right to ask not only "what controls do you have?" but also "what controls will you have, by when, and with what independent evidence?" This Compliance and Certification Roadmap (the "Roadmap") is the Company's public commitment in that direction. It is updated quarterly; the version date is on the front cover.

Items shown here as "targeted" or "in flight" are intended commitments, not declarations of present achievement.

2. Snapshot — what we already have

- BVI company registration .

- Published Terms and Conditions, Privacy and Cookies Policy, and Risk Disclosure Policy on the NovaLink Transparency Portal.
- KYC / KYB onboarding via a third-party provider; mandatory MFA for accounts; encryption in transit and at rest for sensitive data; access restricted to authorised personnel.
- A product-based model: the Company sells products (the Nx1/Hx1 Home Station machine and the Node Telemetry License) and distributes participation rewards, which participants withdraw to their own external crypto wallets. The Company is not a custodian and does not hold customer assets on the customer's behalf.
