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1. About this documentation

This index covers the published trust, compliance, and technical documentation of NovaLink — the technology and product provider serving independent Community Platforms, each operated by its own Community Operator under its own agreements. NovaLink operates through three entities: Ntech Link Technologies Ltd, incorporated in the British Virgin Islands, the Store Operator — it operates the NovaLink Store, the payment processors and payment gateways, and is the seller of record for the Nx1/Hx1 Home Station; Auralink Nova Technology L.L.C, incorporated in Dubai, United Arab Emirates, the Technology Provider — it holds the licence to the Nx1/Hx1 Home Station operating system, integrates it into the Nx1/Hx1 Home Station, provides the Auralink applications, and maintains NovaLink's Dubai office; and Nodelink USA, Inc., a Delaware corporation responsible for distribution and sales in the United States.

Community membership, participation and rewards are governed by each participant's Community Operator under its own agreements, published on the relevant community platform. The entity that issues each document is stated in that document's header; the Corporate Structure & Entity Register (NL-ORG-01) is the authoritative reference for entity roles.

These documents are written for any party with a legitimate interest in how the NovaLink Network operates and is governed — including Node Operators, prospective Node Operators, enterprise customers, Country Distributors, technology and DePIN partners, security researchers, and regulators.

Each document is a stand-alone instrument and may be read on its own. Together they describe the network's acceptable-use rules, its data and security architecture, its regulatory posture across the British Virgin Islands, the European Union and United Kingdom, the United States, and Australia, and the protections available to Node Operators.

4. Suggested reading order for a technical or compliance reviewer

1. NL-SEC-01 — Technical Security Whitepaper (architecture, threat model, controls).
2. NL-ARCH-01 — Network Architecture & Workload Isolation (topology and isolation model).
3. NL-LOGS-01 — Data Minimisation & Retention Policy (what is and is not retained).
4. NL-NOA-01 §§4, 9, and Schedule A — Node Operator Agreement and Indemnity.
5. NL-ROAD-01 — Compliance & Certification Roadmap (independent assurance milestones).
6. Remaining documents as relevant to the reader's role and jurisdiction.

5. Status conventions

Throughout this documentation set, a deliberate distinction is drawn between controls and commitments that are operational today, controls that are in active rollout, and items that are committed-roadmap targets with a target date. Items in the latter two categories are labelled accordingly. NovaLink does not represent a target as a present achievement. The Compliance & Certification Roadmap (NL-ROAD-01) tracks the status of each milestone.

6. Version control

This documentation set is at version 1.0, dated 20 May 2026. Each document carries its own version number in its header and footer. The set is reviewed and refreshed at least quarterly. Material changes are published on the NovaLink legal documentation page and, where a document has been provided to a known recipient, notified to that recipient with a short note describing what changed and why.
